Last term, Kindergarten learned about life on a farm and the changes that occur in plants and animals as they grow. As you would be aware, we were unable to attend our usual farm excursion due to COVID restrictions. Thankfully those restrictions have now been lifted and our excursion is able to go ahead. To reinforce what the children learned we will be visiting Calmsley Hill City Farm. Here the children will have a fantastic opportunity to see a variety of farm animals in the various stages of their development.

The details are as follows:

Venue: Calmsley Hill City Farm

Date: Tuesday 24th November 2020

Cost: \$36 per child. This includes bus fare, entry into the farm and a tractor ride!

Time: Students will need to meet their teacher in their classroom at **8:30am to leave by 8:45am sharp**. We will be travelling by bus and returning to school by 3:20pm.

What to bring: Lunch, fruit break, and a drink in a light weight excursion bag (library bag would be ideal). Please ensure all belongings are labelled with your child's name as there may be other schools attending the farm on our chosen day.

Clothing: Please wear sports uniform, joggers and a school hat.

*Please note we will be travelling in a bus with seatbelts for each child. Parent helpers are **not required** for this excursion.
