Only providers that are essential to the delivery of curriculum can continue to provide services and programs until further notice.

Parents/carers and other non-essential visitors are not allowed on the school site.

All group singing (choirs) and/or other chanting activities, as well as the use of wind instruments in group settings, are not permitted.

Scripture and ethics classes began on Wednesday 19 August 2020 with extra teacher resources in place to ensure grade/stage based students remained together.

P&C meetings and events must be on-line only.

Parent/teacher meetings will be online unless involving serious matters that require face to face discussion.

Our school photos will still proceed on Monday 7 September, 2020. Information has been distributed to students with a hardcopy and via school stream. The note is also on this website FOR PARENTS.

Teachers are still maintaining social distancing procedures therefore professional learning and communication will continue online. Unfortunately COVID restrictions have now included Kindergarten Orientation which we would normally hold in Term 4. We will be providing further information to our new and existing parents about ways we can still disseminate information to you.

Thank you to all the parents who have enrolled their child for 2021 Kindergarten. If parents have new neighbours please let them know that the school is enrolling now. Other than Year 6 could parents please contact the school if their child will not be returning to Oatley PS in 2021.

Our Year 4 students involved in the Opportunity Class test will now be sitting for it at Oatley Public School on Wednesday 18 November 2020. It was due at the end of this term to take place at local high school but this has now been changed to above date and on Oatley PS school site.

Entry to the school for office must be via Letitia Street and signed declaritons will be requested by any adult. This too has been updated throughout this week.

I thank the teaching staff this week for working together to ensure these new protocols are implemented as we care about the safety of your children. Volunteer parents especially at the Canteen and we are extremely grateful for the support and flexibility from our Canteen & Uniform Managers. The service they continue to provide for the school community has been extremely valuable under the present restrictions.
